Instant Impact. Zero Maintenance.

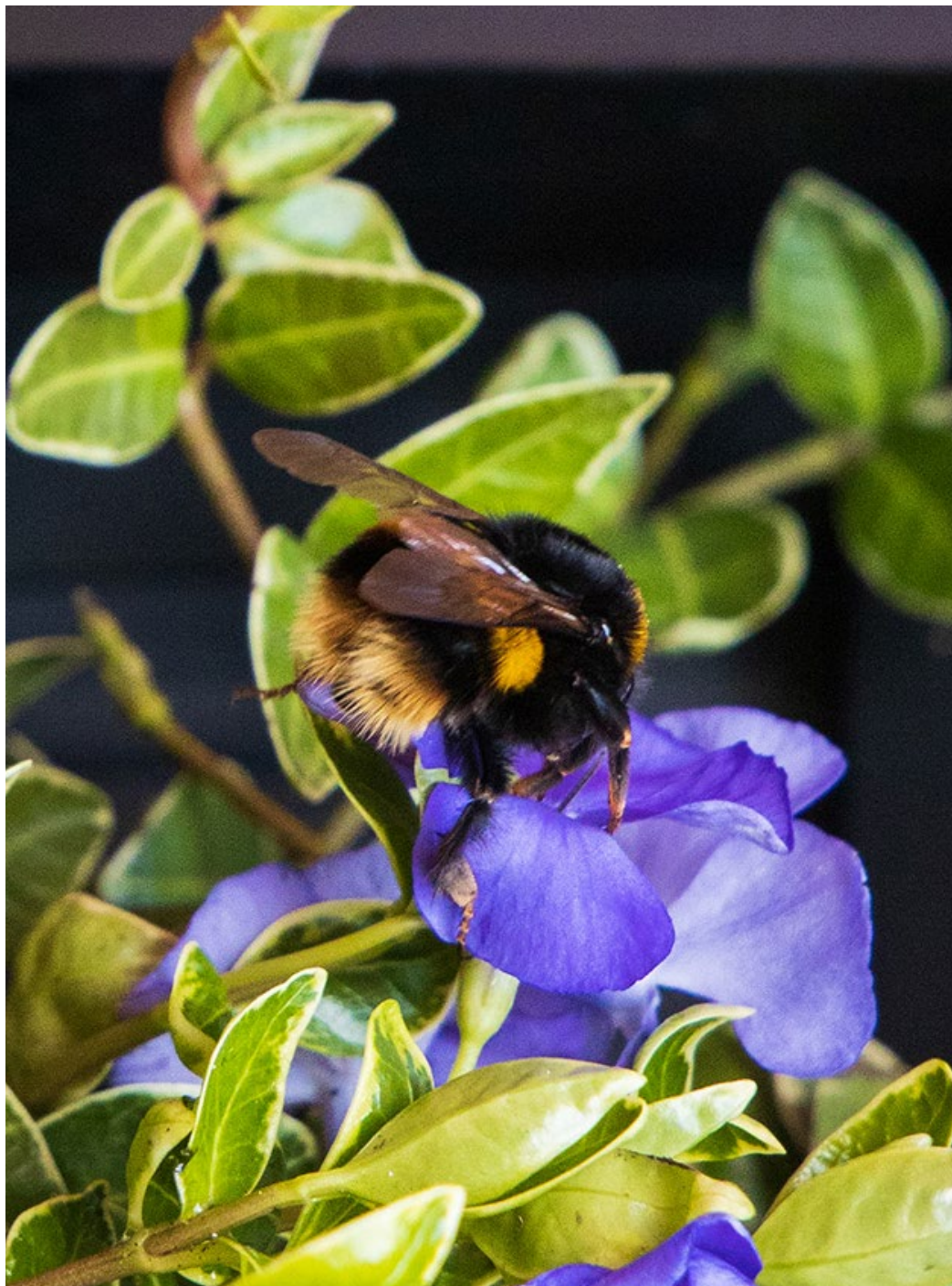

Cleans Air.

The injection of plants a living wall brings can help to improve air quality. They remove carbon dioxide and add oxygen through the natural process of photosynthesis, as well as trap dust particles and harmful pollutants.

Improves Insulation.

Exterior living walls provide great insulation, helping to create more energy efficient buildings.

Deadens Noise.

Living walls can absorb acoustic energy, helping to deaden disturbing ambient noise common to open plan offices and urban living (we're looking at you, road noise!)

Supports Wildlife.

Conserves Water.

Our irrigation systems use only the amount of water needed and can even still be used in a hosepipe ban.

CASE STUDY 1

A Miniature Wildlife Haven.

The owner of this garden wanted to make the most of her small terrace. An unused area underneath the kitchen window now packs a punch, full of life and vibrant colour. The brief was to make the garden more wildlife friendly as well as to grow a variety of herbs. We planted thyme, rosemary and mint as well as erysimum, primulas and periwinkles, all with purple and pink blooms that especially attract bees and other pollinators.

This really demonstrates the versatility of even smaller living walls, contributing to habitat for local wildlife as well as being a beautiful feature for the owner to enjoy.

CASE STUDY 2

A New-Build Garden.

The owners used to refer to their garden as “a little grey square”. They were struggling to find the balance between injecting personality whilst also keeping it low-maintenance. We installed a large living wall that spans the entire back fence of their garden, completely changing the feel of the space.

We filled the wall with low-maintenance planting including ferns, ivy and heuchera, that would provide year round colour and interest. We also fully irrigated the wall so the owners wouldn’t have to worry about when and how much to water their new plants.

CASE STUDY 3

A Farmhouse Garden.

We installed this living wall at a farmhouse garden located in Hertfordshire. The plants help to soften the aged brick, creating a relaxed seating area.

The planting, which was made up of variegated grasses, heuchera wild rose and heuchera winter joy, brings an array of textures and year round colour - providing an ideal corner for sipping a glass of chilled rosé whilst enjoying the beautiful countryside sunset.

This is a great example to show that living walls can complement traditional settings as well as modern gardens.

CASE STUDY 6

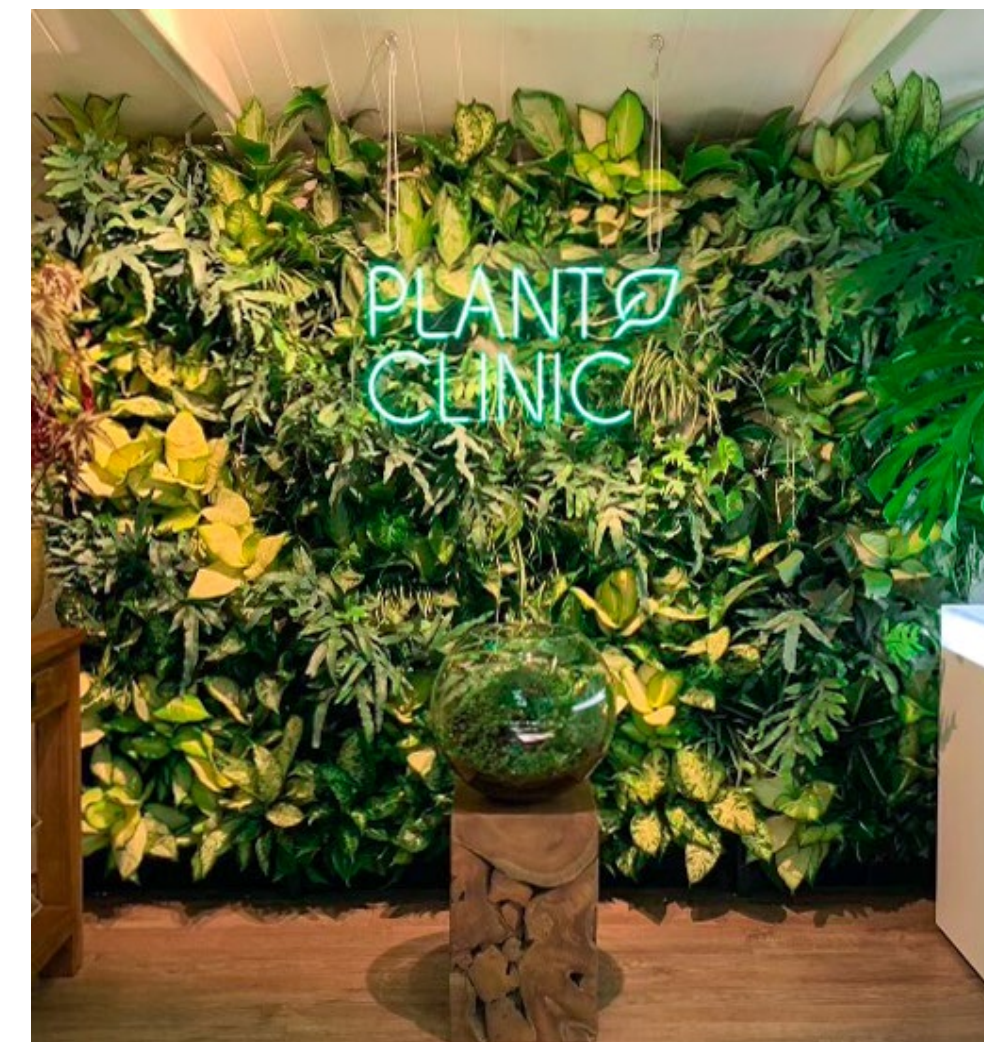
A Living Exhibition Booth.

CASE STUDY 7

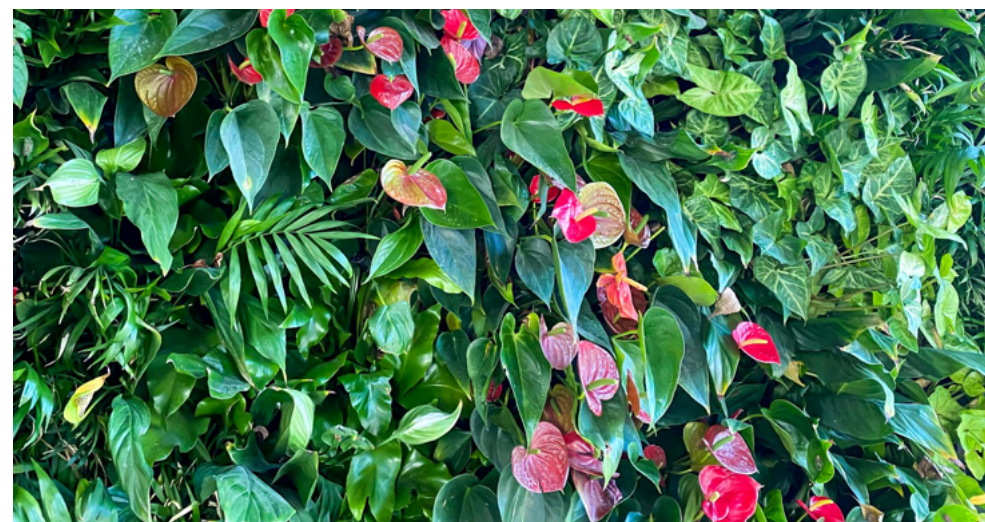
A Striking Office Entryway.

The large windows let in natural light all day, so the planting needed to be able to withstand direct sunlight. As a busy place of work, the planting also needed to stay lush and healthy with very little upkeep. The irrigation system means that it is both safe and low-maintenance, ensuring the wall will continue thriving for years to come.

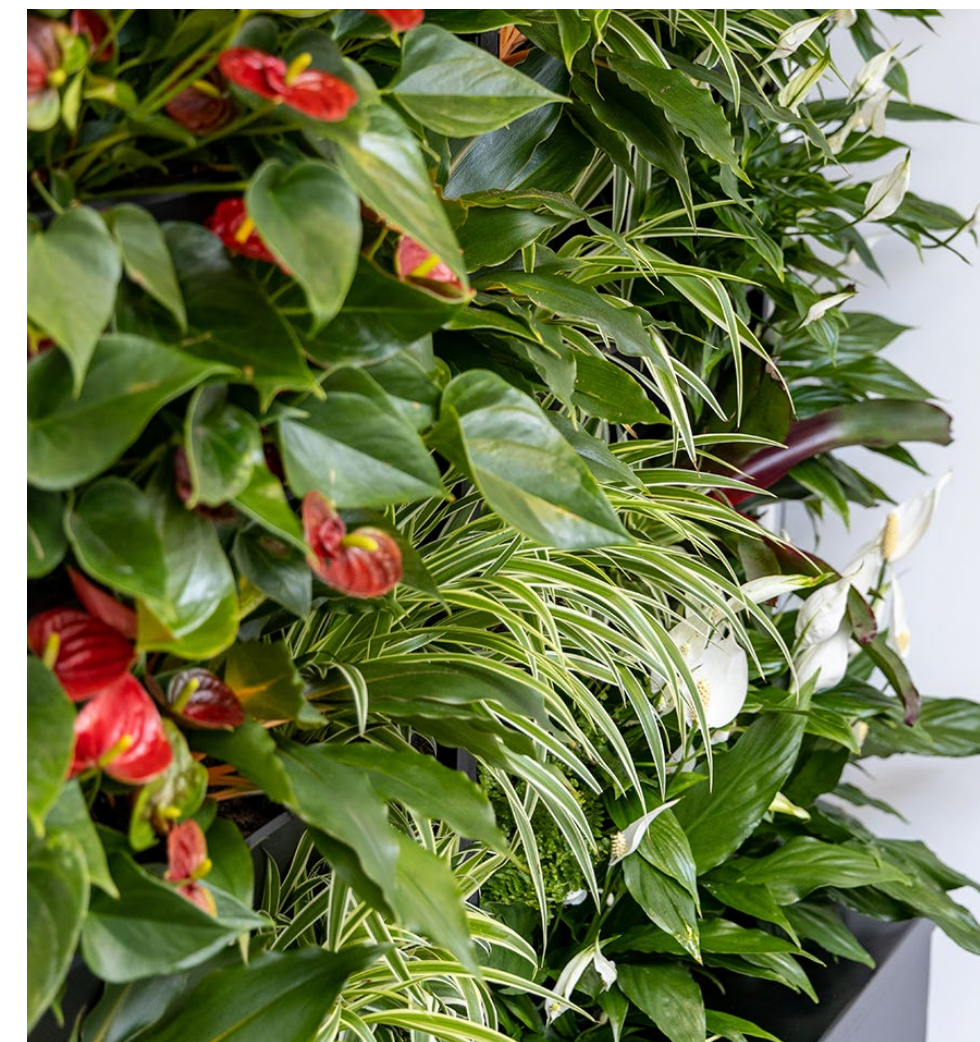
CASE STUDY 8

A Tropical Style Interior Wall.

An interior living wall allows you to choose from an array of interesting plants. With the use of Spathiphyllum (peace lilies), Anthurium, Neoregelia as well as various grasses and ferns, we've achieved a tropical, lush feel for this office living wall.

Two small pumps are housed in a concealed tank underneath the wall. One to feed the irrigation, and another to circulate the water through a UV light which prevents any bacterial contamination of the water. A low-maintenance, high-impact feature for any home or office.
